Task Two:

Choose one of the paintings from Task One and answer these questions underneath the painting in the Word document:

1. What is the name of the still life painting that you have chosen?
2. Who painted it?
3. When was it painted?
4. What was used to create this portrait (oil paint, watercolour, pastel, acrylic, collage, printing etc?)
5. What is happening in the painting?
6. What catches your eye the most in this painting? Why?
7. Do you think that it was painted carefully?
8. Please describe the colours in this painting as carefully as possible.
9. Describe any lines you can see in the painting. Have they been used for an outline, to create pattern or any other reason? Are they thick, thin, straight, swirly etc.?
10. Do the objects look flat (2D) or 3D? Why?
11. Do you think that the artist carefully arranged the objects in this painting? Please explain your answer.
12. Why do you think this artist chose these objects? Do you think that they are an interesting choice? Please explain as carefully as possible.
13. Do you like this painting? Please explain your answer.

Task Three:

Please choose another painting from Task One and answer the questions in Task Two. Please choose a painting that is as different as possible as your first choice.
