Qualifications Scotland Results & Appeals 2026

As our school year concludes, and our school office closes for the summer, please note the important points below in relation to Qualifications Scotland results and appeals.

School Office Hours – Summer

Our school office will close for the summer at 12pm on Friday 3 July and reopen at 8.45am on Monday 10 August, following normal school hours: 8.45am - 3.40pm (Mon - Wed); 8.45am - 2.50pm (Thurs - Fri).

Accessing Exam Results

Qualifications Scotland results day is Tuesday 4 August 2026.

Qualifications Scotland will post Scottish Qualifications Certificates to all pupils at their recorded home address on Tuesday 4 August. In addition, pupils can also have their exam results text and/or emailed to them from 8.00am on results day, but they must register for this service by Wednesday 15 July via the Qualifications Scotland website:

Appeals

Pupils should only appeal if they believe a mistake has been made in the external marking of their work and it should be noted the after being reviewed, the exam result could stay the same, go up or go down.

Principal teachers of Guidance will be available from 1.30pm on Monday 17 August to help with any subject/pathway related queries from pupils who have not achieved the results they had anticipated or the results they may require for progressing in their intended pathway.
