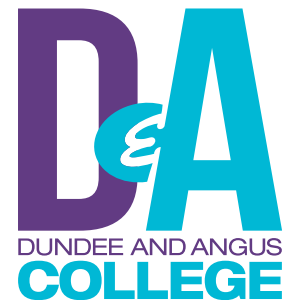

You will spend part of your school week attending college at either Gardyne or Kingsway Campus

Most courses run on Monday and Wednesday afternoons starting at 2pm – see course info for details

Very broad range of subjects to choose from, at a range of levels

Structure of Courses

Qualifications range from SCQF Level 5 (same as National 5 level) to SCQF Level 7 (same as HNC/ first year of university)

Course involve a mix of practical work and theory

Assessment is on-going (e.g. observations, essays, projects), rather than being an exam at the end of the course

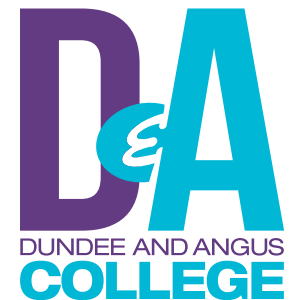

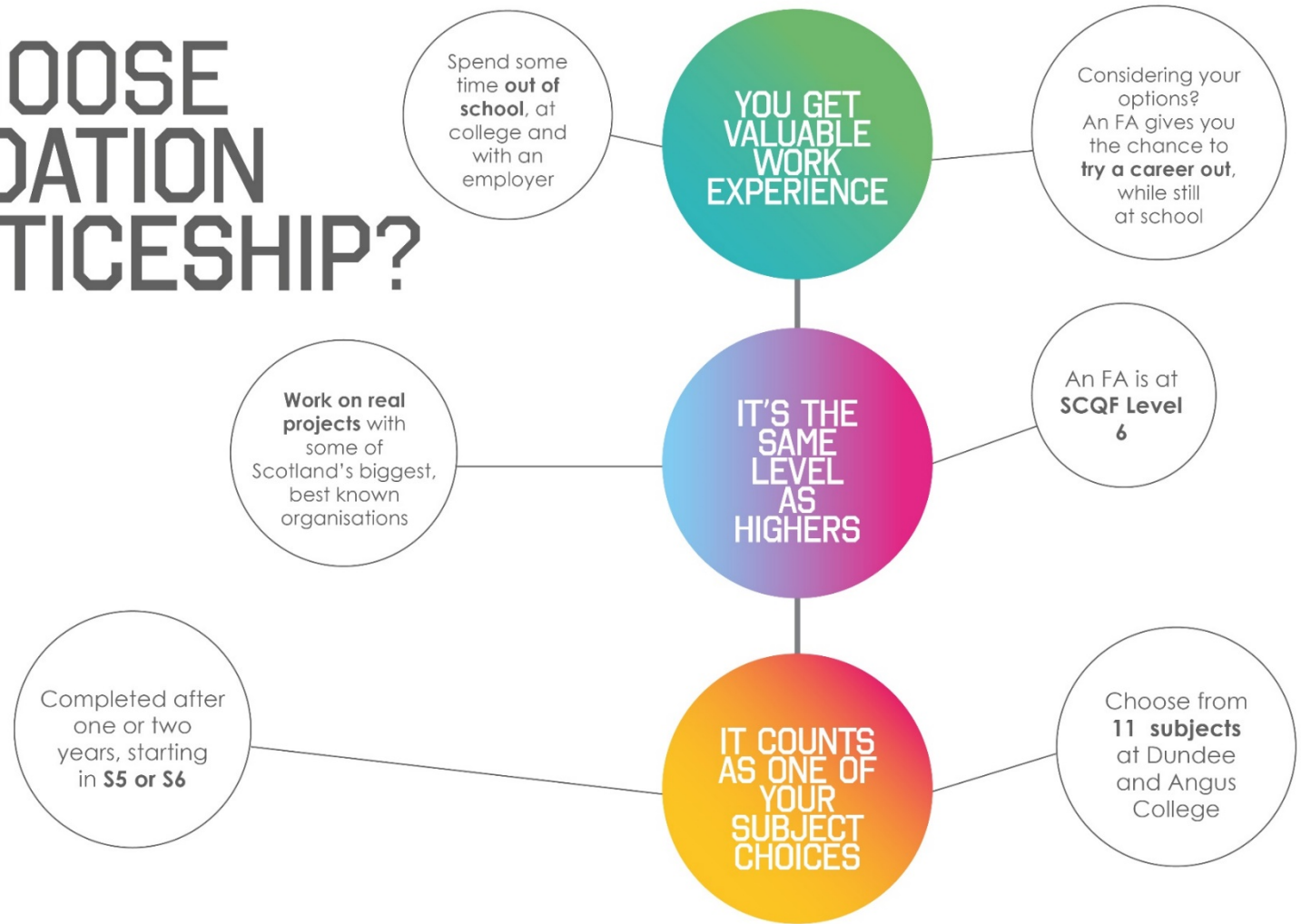
