I am sure you will be aware, on Monday 14 June, Scotland's national football team competes in their first major men's tournament for 23 years.

At Baldragon Academy, we are celebrating this by taking a little bit of time from our normal learning timetable to learn a little bit more about the event and to back our national team.

Therefore:

- On Thursday 10 June during period 6, all pupils will be given the chance to test their knowledge on Scottish football and the UEFA EURO 2020 competition by taking part in a competition quiz.
- On Monday 14 June, all pupils and staff are encouraged to dress down and wear something Scottish or wear something blue which can include the official Scotland football team shirt. There is no fund raising associated with this dress down day.
- On Monday afternoon, from 2pm, all teachers in all classrooms will show the Scotland v Czech Republic football match.
- All the correct answers from the EURO 2020 quiz will be entered into a prize draw. A selected number will be drawn, and these pupils will be given a 'golden ticket' to watch the game as a VIP in our assembly hall on the big screen. VIPs will also receive some hospitality.
