You must base your choices on the subjects you studied in S4. You may select any combination of Higher and N4/5 courses. For every N4 or N5 course you choose, you will have an additional period allocated to a nationally accredited skills qualification in learning, life and work. You may choose a college course in Column C and/or Column D. Some college courses offer progression but others do not. Look for information in the School/College Programme Booklet and plan your pathway carefully. You must continue 2 year college courses (HNC or Foundation Apprenticeship) into S6.
