Term 1 Updates

I'd like to take this opportunity to provide you with a few updates and to thank you for your continued support for our school as we bring term 1 to a close.

Attainment and Achievement

I am pleased, following the 2021/22 exam diet, that pupil attainment and achievement continues to improve at Baldragon Academy. More young people are attaining across the measures of literacy and numeracy at <u>SCQF</u> level 4 and level 5. Overall, numbers achieving at National 4, National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher are also improving - some steadily; some rapidly. I look forward to sharing more on this at our Parent Council AGM early next month. Young people are excelling in our new School of Sport. Resources and kit have been arriving this term and we continue to generate interest at a national level from local universities and national governing bodies. Our Rural Skills and Bee Academy is another new initiative that is making a huge impact. We have been celebrating our community Harvest Fest and our young beekeepers won 3 awards at the Scottish National Honey show. Our Barista Academy has been active too – most recently serving our S2 parents at parents' night. By logging into your ParentPay account, you can purchase our school honey, honeycomb, 'Baldragon Brews' mugs, travel mugs and tote bags.

Behaviour of pupils in our community

If your child is choosing to make use of the local shops for their lunch, can you please help us to reinforce the messages of good citizenship.
